### (MUNGGUI)

I use this name for the language spoken in the villages of Munggui, Windesi (to be distinguished from the village with the same name in the Wandamen area), Puramati and Morui. Two dialects can be distinguished in Munggui, one spoken in Windesi and Murui, the other in Munggui and Puramati. Munggui speakers number more than 650.
